## Providers Using Storyboard

The Storyboard is a workspace tool designed to provide quicker access to key details and common actions without exiting current workflow. This feature is available across applications, specializing tools based on user role, specialty and other contexts. Patient information previously captured in the patient header is now found in the Storyboard. The activity tabs are now displayed at the top of the workspace.

## Key Information Found In Storyboard

Key information found in the Storyboard includes:
I. Demographics
2. Code Status
3. Principal problem
4. Isolations, infections and allergies
5. Treatment Team members
6. Track most recent medication administration
7. Review labs, etc.


Activity tab visibility is dependent on device display settings and monitor size. Click the down arrow to view additional navigators and options.

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## Viewing Information in the Storyboard

The Storyboard displays general information at a glance. To view more detailed information, hover over the items you want to view.


To view a medication or lab order report, after hovering, select the item to view from the resulting pop- up. Click on any hyperlink within the Storyboard to navigate to that area within the patients chart. See screenshot below.

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
