

4P Communication: 2023 BBP Education Notice for Leaders

<p>Purpose: <i>Why are we doing this?</i></p>	<p>BBP education is a team member safety and compliance issue. Education helps protect our team members, patients, and the organization. BBP education assists in maintaining financial health for the organization. Each willful violation committed by the employer, intentionally and knowingly, can lead to substantial financial impact.</p>
<p>Picture: <i>What will it look like when we get there?</i></p>	<p>OSHA regulations and Novant Health policy requires that all risk category 1 team members and providers receive BBP education:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • every year <i>and</i> • within 365 days of the prior year of training - <i>training will occur June 1 to June 30 in 2023.</i>
<p>Plan: <i>What is our plan to change?</i></p>	<p>In 2023, the required online course, CEG0042 June 2023 Bloodborne Pathogens (BBP) Education, will be completed by ALL Novant Health team members (risk categories 1 & 2) and providers. The course will be pushed and available on June 1, 8 a.m. – you can not assign this education to a team member, it is only available via a push.</p> <p><i>Team members who attend Novant Health orientation beginning June 2023, will have met the June 2023 BBP training requirement – no need to complete BBP a second time.</i></p> <p>Access will be available via I-Learn and/or the Cornerstone mobile app called "Learn" (a QR code will be made available to grant instant access on a mobile device).</p> <p>Please note: Accessing BBP Education via I-Learn (desktops/laptops) requires the use of either Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge.</p> <p>If a team member who is assigned the education does not complete the education by the deadline, network access may be temporarily suspended until it is completed. If this occurs, the team member will be able to access I-Learn via http://novanthealthlearning.csod.com to take the course. Once it has been completed, network access will be restored.</p> <p>Team members who are on leave of absence will have five (5) days to complete the module upon their return.</p>
