DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GATHER SUPPLIES

- Trash receptacle placed bedside
- Chux or absorbent pad
- Clean gloves
- SureStep™ Post Insertion Foley Care Pack





PROCEDURAL SETUP


- Wash hands and don clean gloves
- Place absorbent pad or chux beneath patient
- Remove all 5 wipes from pack and set on absorbent pad
- Place empty pack to side to reference directions and to use orange compliance sticker following completion of procedure
- Note: The Foley catheter can remain secured to the patient throughout the procedure.



FEMALE PROCEDURE



Start at the meatal junction, gently cleanse the first 1-2" of Foley then stabilize Foley with non-dominant hand while cleaning the remainder of the catheter to the bifurcation.



Clean meatus and distal (far side) labia




LABIA Clean proximal (nearside) labia



Clean each inner thigh with a separate cloth in a downward motion

MALE PROCEDURE



Start at the meatal junction, gently cleanse the first 1-2" of Foley then stabilize Foley with non-dominant hand while cleaning the remainder of the catheter to the bifurcation.



Clean meatus and glans



Clean shaft and scrotum



Clean each inner thigh with a separate cloth in a downward motion

Discard soiled wipe in bedside trash receptacle after each step

Orange Sticker Placement

- Remove orange sticker from front of SureStep[™] Foley Care pack
- Place sticker on BARD® compliance calendar
- Calendar Key:
 - AM hours represented by a sun
 - PM hours represented by a moon

*Follow hospital policy for Foley care frequency and documentation

- Do not microwave
