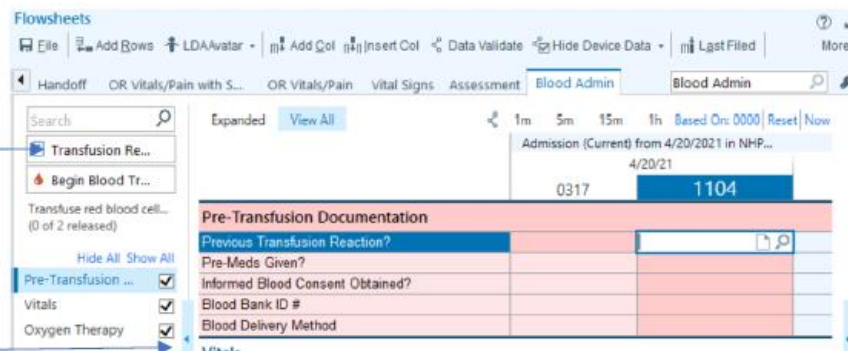
After you place the order for Fast Blood call the blood bank to notify. You DO NOT need to release the blood from flowsheets to get the blood from the blood bank. Once you get the blood from the blood bank you will need to go to flowsheets to “release” the blood that you received from the blood bank to be able to scan the blood into dimensions to give it to the patient.
