



Outlook Period: Friday 3/8/24 - Sunday 3/10/24

## OVERVIEW

Clouds will increase today ahead of low pressure that will bring heavy rain and possible strong to severe thunderstorms Saturday. The low will move offshore Saturday night, ending rain chances and bringing cooler and drier air to the Carolinas Sunday.

### HAZARDS & IMPACTS

#### LAND:

A **slight risk (threat level 2 of 5)** of severe weather on Saturday.

A **slight risk (level 2 of 5)** of excessive rainfall on Saturday.

#### MARINE:

A **Small Craft Advisory** is in effect from 4 am Saturday to 8 am Sunday

#### RIVER and COASTAL FLOODING:

- Minor coastal flooding is possible at the beaches and downtown during high tides early morning on Saturday
- Some of the rivers will continue on the rise across the area.
